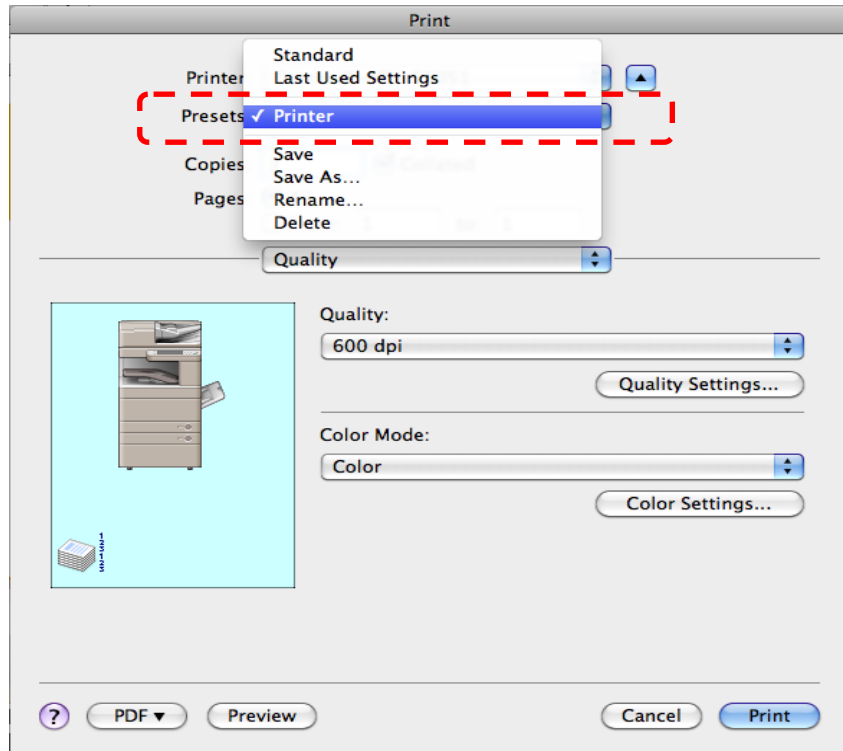


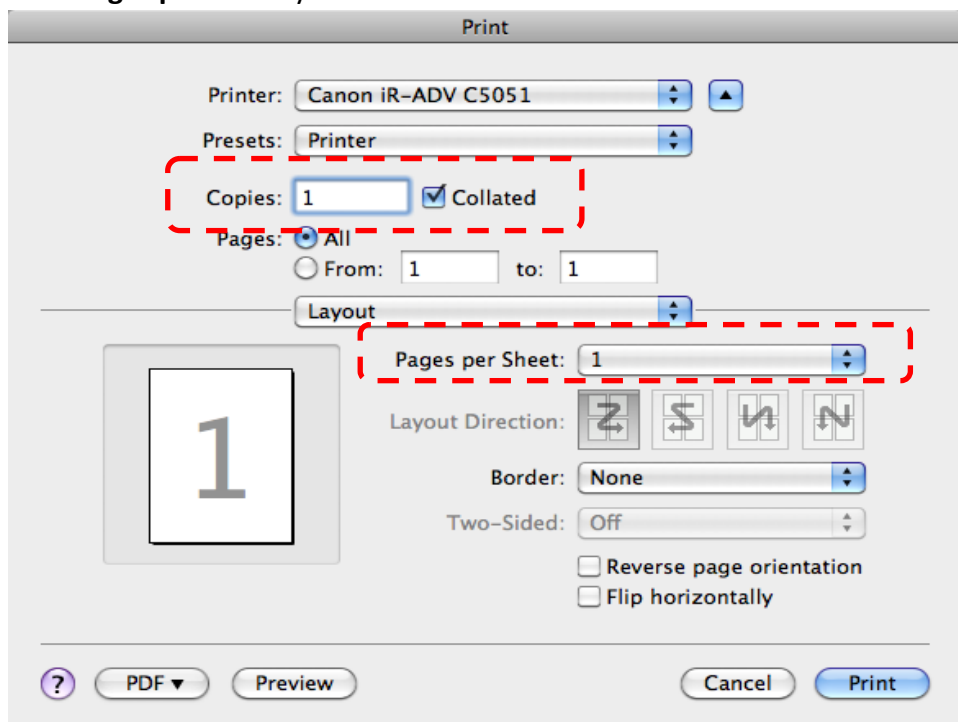

Canon C5051 Copier - User Guide for Printing

1. Firstly, you need to choose “**Printer**” from the **Presets** item when clicking the print function.

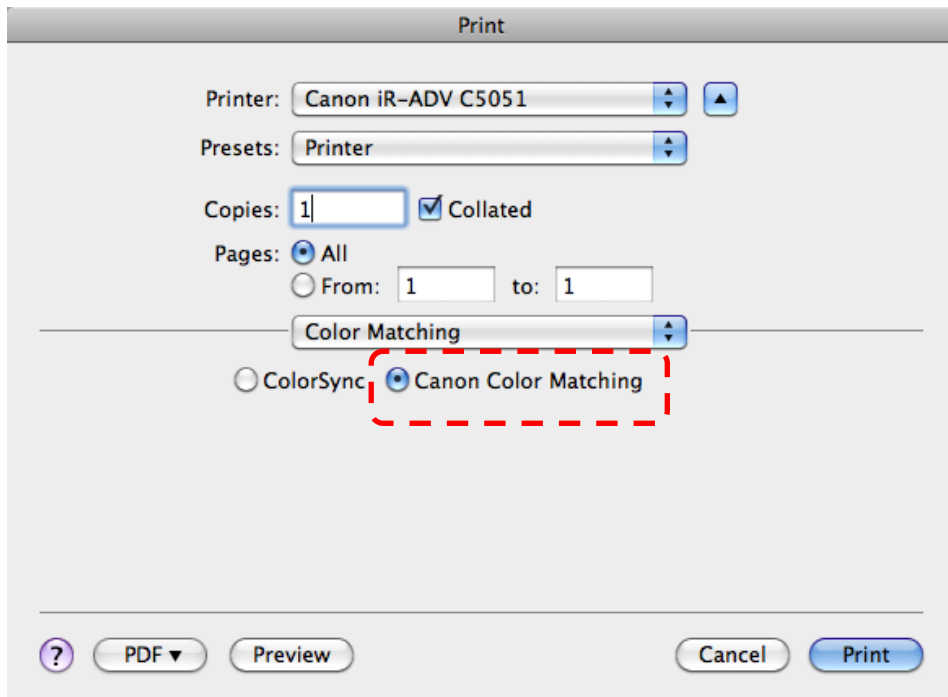


2. Input the **number of Copies** into **Copies** item. Select “**Layout**” on the middle menu bar and select **Pages per Sheet** you need.

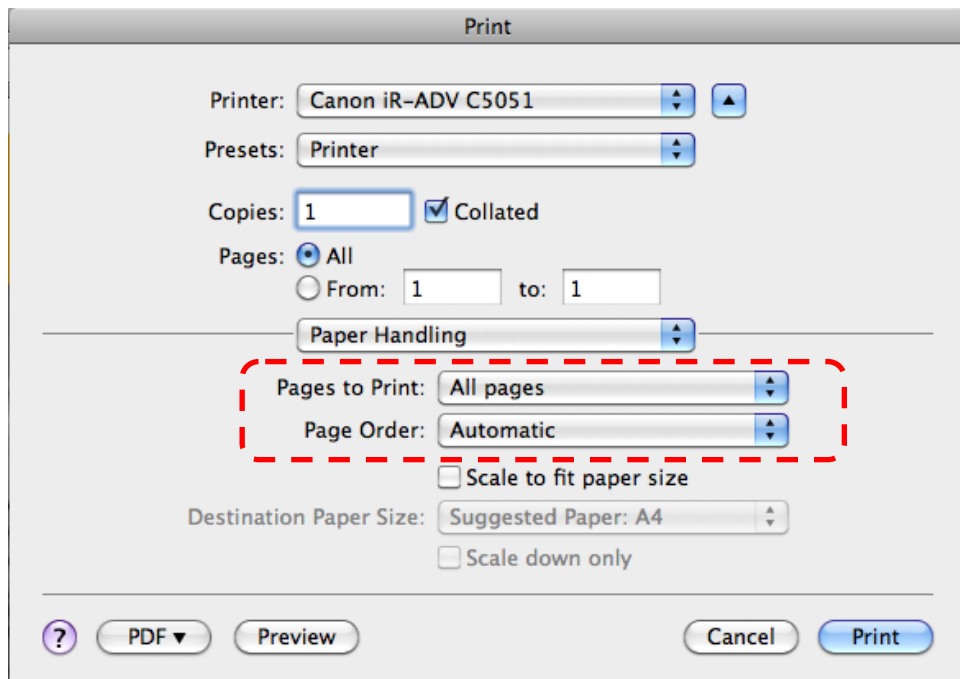

3. Select “**Color Matching**” on the middle menu bar and click the **Canon Color Matching** button.



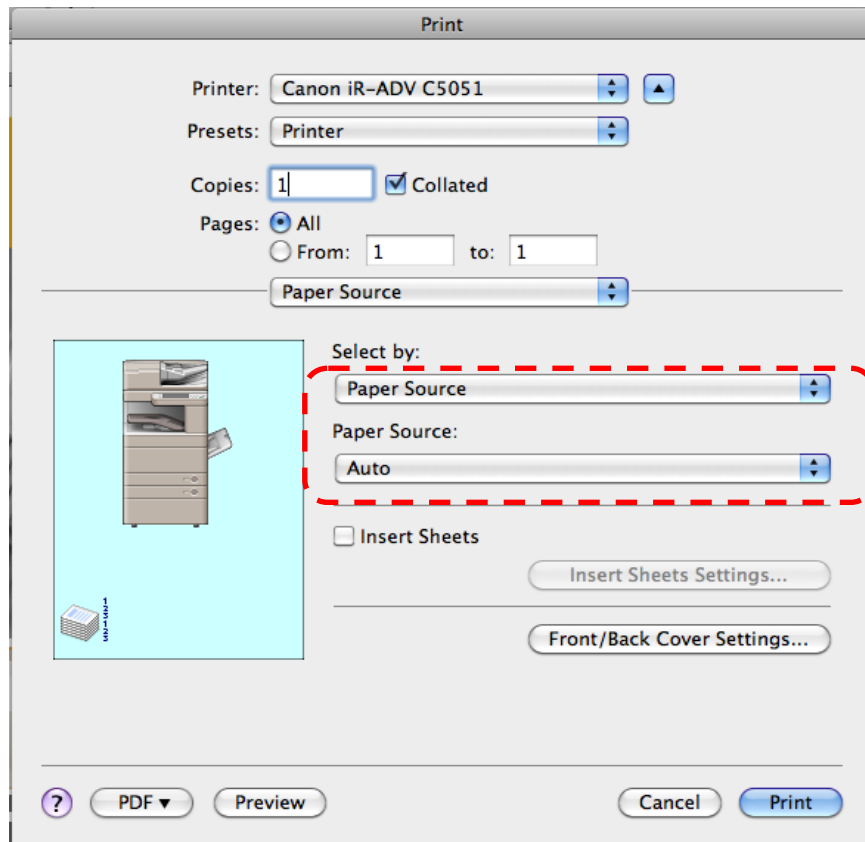
4. Select “**Paper Handling**” on the middle menu bar, choose which **pages** you want to print and the **page order**.

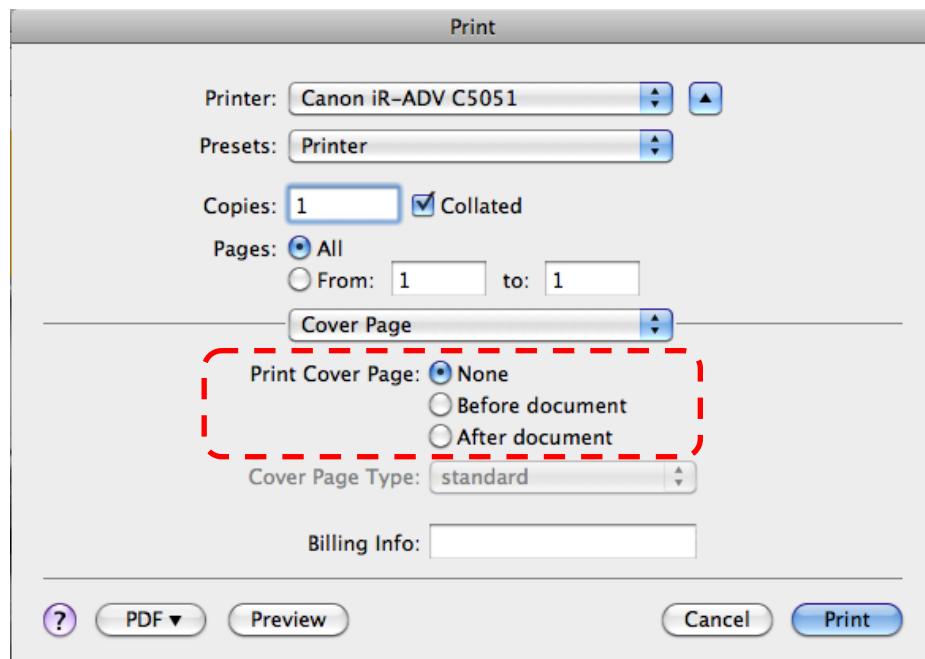
5. Select “Paper Source” on the middle menu bar, select paper source and auto.

** This part default is Paper Source and Auto, please do not change any items or settings.



6. Select “Cover Page” on the middle menu bar.

** Default is None and please do not change any items or settings.

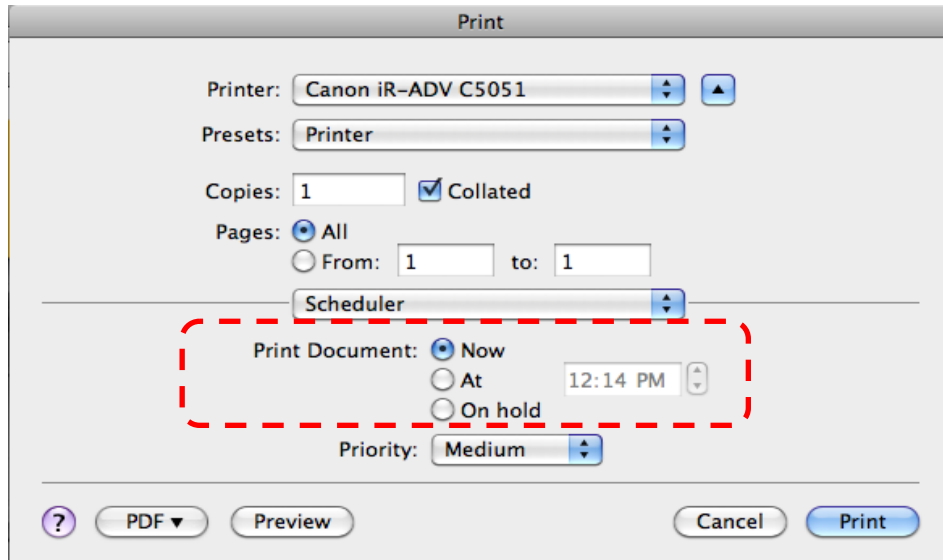

7. Select “**Scheduler**” on the middle menu bar, set up the print time.

** Default is **Now**, if you do not need to extend the print time.

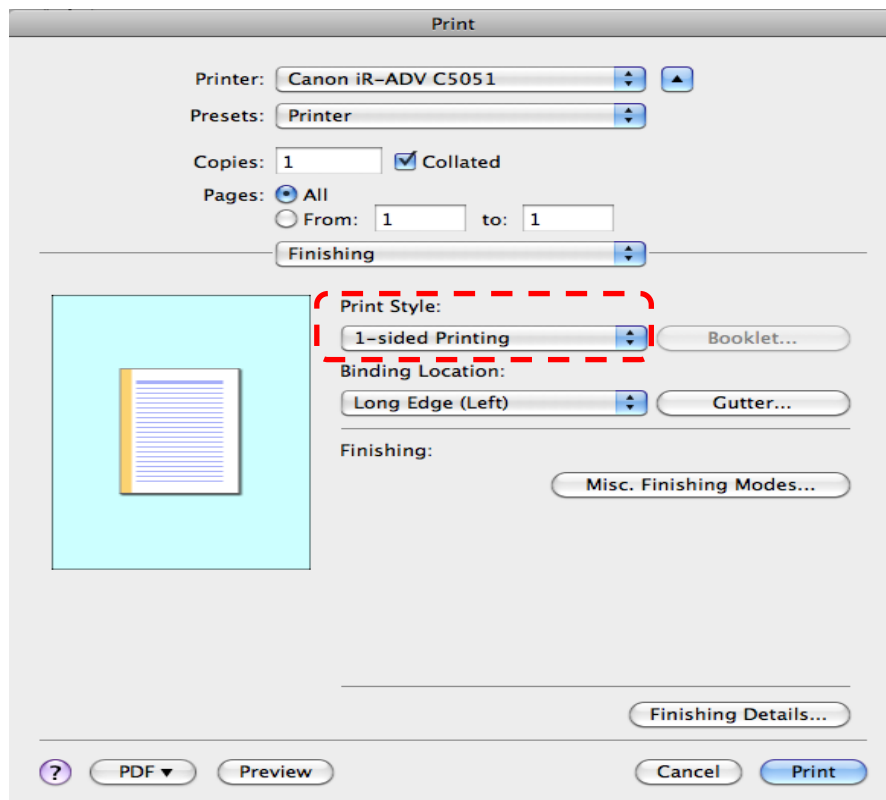
If you want to extend the print time, click **At** or **On hold**, please also set the timer on the right. The important thing is, the pending time for printing can only be **holding for an hour in maximum**.



8. Select “**Finishing**” on the middle menu bar, select the **print style**.

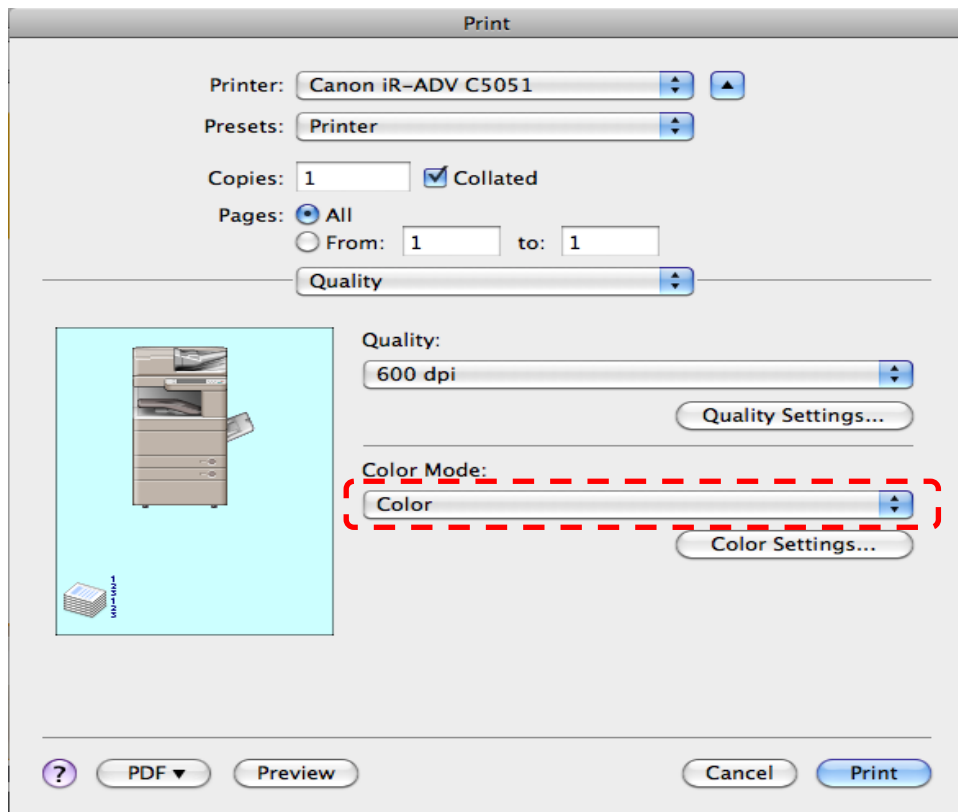
** Default is **1-sided Printing**. You can change to **2-sided Printing** when necessary.

** **Do not click “Booklet” on this Canon Copier, no such function can be provided.**

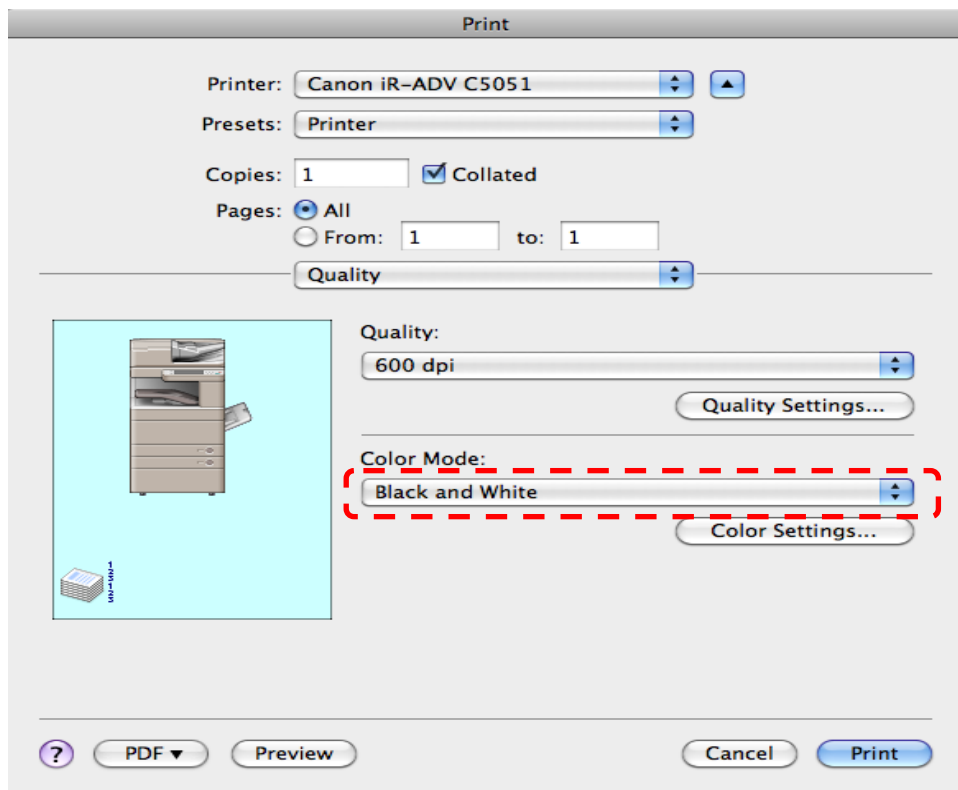

9. Select “Quality” on the middle menu bar, and the color from the **Color Mode** item.



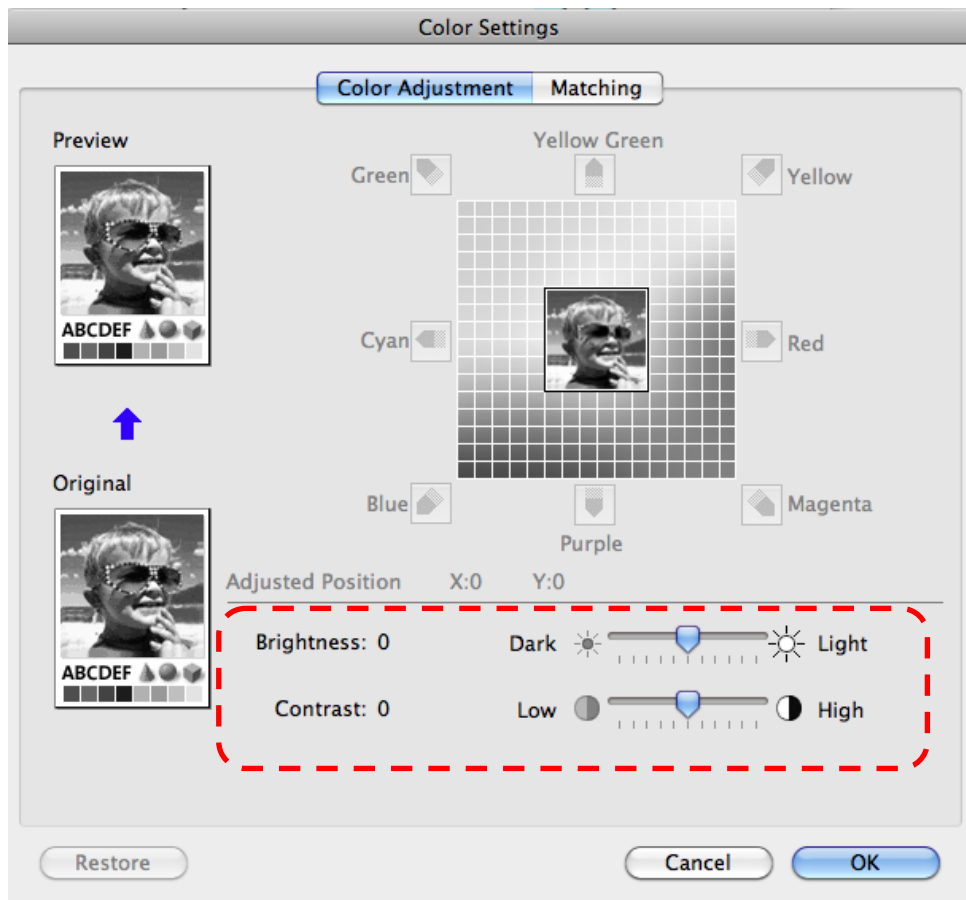

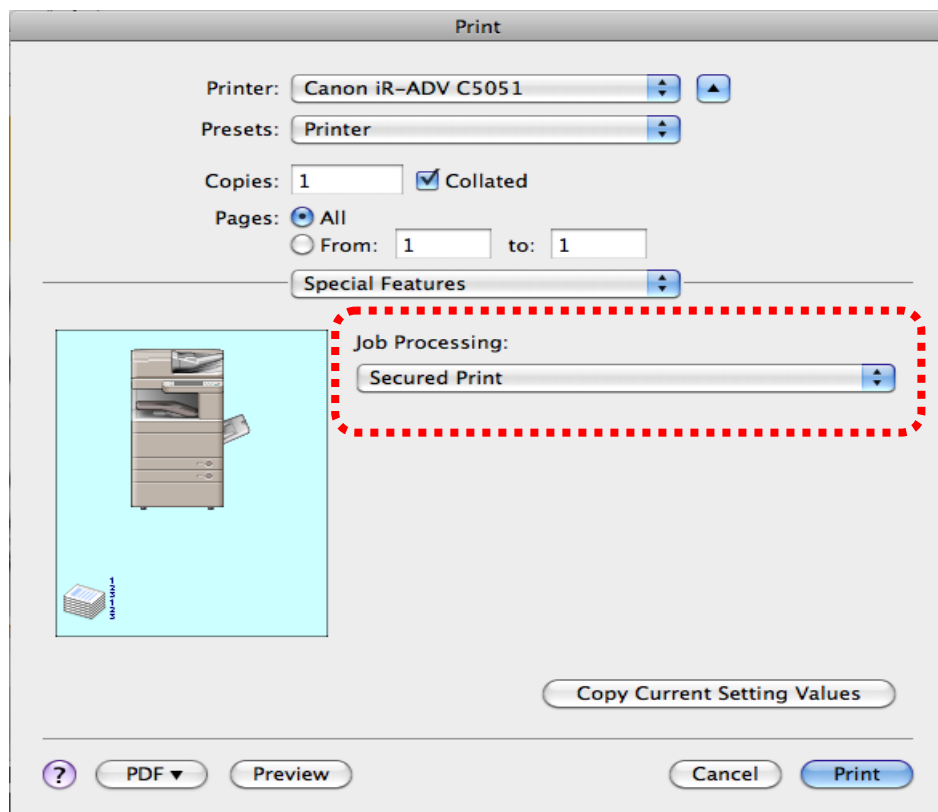
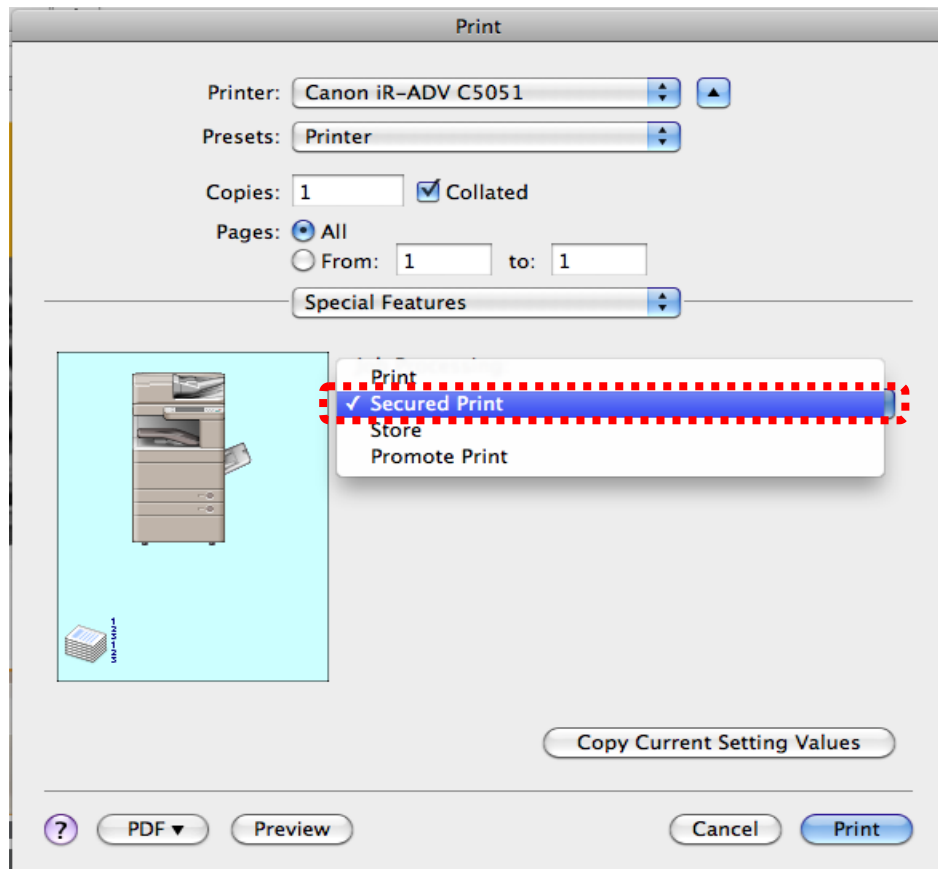

10. When you click the **Color Settings...** on the bottom of right, the system will prompt the following **Color Settings**. You can set the **Brightness** and **Contrast** on the **Color Adjustment** page.

11. Select “**Special Features**” on the middle menu bar, **make sure** you have selected the “**Secured Print**” item. **If you haven’t selected this item, you will be failed to print.**

12. When you have finished all the steps, click the **“Print”** button.

The system will prompt this **Secured Print** message box, please input **the entire white box**.

****** Make sure and remember your input **text** and **PIN number**, because you need to select your document file and input the correct **PIN number** again on the Canon Copier touch screen.

**** All the Document Name, User Name and PIN number are not designated; you can set them according to your own preference.**
